



POSITION: Summer Day Camp Work Study

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide a safe, fun, positive, helpful learning experience for Outdoors for All program participants.
- Maintain accurate attendance records.
- Load and unload recreational equipment including cycles, canoes, lifejackets, trailers, etc.
- Help with the planning of weekly day camp schedules.
- Supervise day camp volunteers.
- Communicate daily with participant family members and care providers.
- Drive participants in Outdoors for All owned vans.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Conduct Emergency Procedures when required. Complete incident reports when necessary.
- Record outgoing messages, and check voicemails on the program hotline.

EXPECTATIONS:

- Punctuality. Staff needs to arrive to work on time, each day.
- Provide a safe, fun, positive, helpful learning experience for Outdoors for All participants.
- Current Washington State Drivers License, and insurability for those driving vehicles.
- Develop and/or refine disability knowledge, sport techniques, and adaptive techniques.
- No drug or alcohol consumption during shift or working under the influence of drugs and alcohol.
- No smoking during shift, unless on break, and in a designated smoking area away from Out doors for All activities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Appropriate certification is desirable: First Aid, CPR, WSI, CDL, etc.
- Ability to work with a wide variety of people, skill levels and disabilities.
- Knowledge regarding people with disabilities and recreational activities.
- Leadership, communication, motivation, teaching, mentoring, and people skills.
- Ability to commit to all Responsibilities and Expectations.
- Positive attitude.

COMPENSATION:

- Seasonal employment June – August. Salary range \$9-\$12 per hour. No medical benefits.
