What is Outdoors for All?

Outdoors for All is a non-profit in your community that transforms the quality of life for children & adults with disabilities through outdoor recreation. Outdoors for All started as the Ski for All foundation in 1979. Outdoors for All serves over 2,000 individuals with disabilities using over 700 fully-trained volunteers to provide one-on-one assistance. Outdoors for All provides opportunities in activities such as skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, cycling, rock climbing, rafting, hiking, camping, kayaking, canoeing and water skiing.

What is Spree at Alpentel?

Spree at Alpentel is Outdoors for All's second largest fundraiser of the year! As a Spree participant you receive an all-day lift ticket to Alpentel, lunch from Red Robin, t-shirt, chances to win sweet gear and prizes, live entertainment, après Spree beer garden pass (adults 21 and over), and demos from 15 ski and snowboard reps like K2, Ride, Rossignol, Atomic and many more thanks to Sturtevant's. It's a really fun event for groups or individuals. Skiing, snowboarding – and snowshoeing – all to support a great cause, the Outdoors for All Foundation.

How much does Spree cost?

Spree costs \$79 per person OR \$49 for individuals who have a Summit at Snoqualmie Big 5 Season Pass. You can also fundraise as a team and pledge to raise \$1,000 to support Outdoors for All.

Where do I register/check-in?

Registration is in the Powder House Lodge. You also can buy a Spree voucher at the Alpentel ticket window and then go register/check-in at the event in the Powder House.

Where do volunteers check-in?

Volunteers should check-in and check out at the Volunteer Check-In in the Powder House Lodge.

What activities are going on at Spree?

There are ski, snowboard, telemark and snowshoe demo opportunities today. Besides the snow fun we also have a silent auction in the Powder House with over \$5,000 in silent auction items, a sweet raffle with killer prizes like skis and season pass, Pyramid beer garden and live band, Hot Bodies in Motion. We also have our snowshoes available and two scheduled snowshoe trips during the day.

What is a demo?

A demo is a chance for you as a Spree participant to try some of the new 2012 skis and snowboards that are out there. We also have Outdoors for All's fleet of snowshoes for you to try out as well.

Do you have boots and poles?

You must provide your own boots and poles for the event. Snowshoes we provide poles but not for skiing.

What demo reps are here today?

K2, Line, Burton, Ride, Atomic, Swix, Head, Salomon, Nordica, Fisher, Rossignol, Blizzard, Volkl and more!

What is the race course for?

As an individual you can compete to get best time of the day. We will have a prize for top female racer and top male racer. Race course is open from 10AM - 2PM.

What time are the snowshoe trips?

10:00AM - 11:30PM and 1:30PM - 2:30PM. The van leaves at 10AM, so plan to go to the tent to get setup on snowshoes at least 30 minutes prior to departure time.

Where are the restrooms?

There are two set of restrooms:
 1. Men/women on second floor in Powder House (west building).
 2. Men/women on bottom floor of Alpentel Lodge (east building).
 Accessibility issues? Use path on back side of building of Alpentel Lodge. Please ask us for assistance if you need it!

When does the beer garden open?

The Pyramid beer garden opens at 2:30PM and is closed promptly at 5:00PM (or when beer runs out). Beer garden is for Spree guests only. 21+. Must show your ID and get a bracelet.

What time is lunch for Spree guests?

Lunch from Red Robin starts at 11:30AM and goes till about 1:30PM. Served in the Powderhouse Lodge.

When will prizes and contest winners be announced?

Starting around 3:15PM we will start drawing contest winners. At 3:30PM we will announce team and individual fundraising winners and race course top individual racers.

Who sponsors/supports Spree at Alpentel?

Where can I buy RAFFLE TICKETS?

There will be volunteers walking around in ORANGE guide bibs. They will have tickets. 1 for \$5 or 3 for \$10! You can also purchase them at the VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN area after 11am in the Powderhouse Lodge. Cash or check is preferred but we can take credit card at the volunteer check-in. Will will announce raffle winners around 3:30pm. YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN.

Where is the Silent Auction and what items are there?

We have thousands of dollars in items in our silent auction! Skis, snowboards, snowshoes, bags, and more! Bidding is open until 4:00PM. Items are located in the Powderhouse Lodge near the Volunteer Check-In. You can pay for your item and collect item at the Volunteer Check-In starting at 4:00PM. You can pay via cash, check or credit card.
