SPREE VOLUNTEER GENERAL DETAILS

Hello all you wonderful volunteers!

Thank you for being willing to support Outdoors for All as a volunteer at this year's Spree at Alpentel on Saturday, March 10th, 2012.

Below you will find general information regarding the Spree and your time volunteering with us. Remember, in order to get free access to everything at Spree we ask that you volunteer a minimum of 4 hours. For that you get all the perks of a registration. If your shift is only 3 hours we will ask you to help out with another task at some point to fulfill your 4 hours. For those that are helping out all day...THANK YOU! It is greatly appreciated.

You will be contacted via email or phone this week to confirm your time and details for your volunteer role. You should hear from us by Wednesday, March 7, 2012 (at the latest) on your specific times and roles. Call us if you have any questions in the mean time. We ask for your patience as we contact volunteers as we have over 75 volunteers to contact individually to make sure they have the information they need!

GETTING THERE/DIRECTIONS:

Thank you for traveling from all over Washington for our event. The directions differ, obviously, from where you are coming from. Alpentel is on the same exit as Summit West (Exit #52).

- From Seattle/Metro Area: Take I-90 East to Exit 52 for Summit West and Alpentel. At stop sign turn left.
- From Cle Elum/Ellensburg/Spokane: Take I-90 West to Exit 53 for Summit West and Alpentel
- Physical Address: 17701 Alpentel Access Road Snoqualmie Pass, WA 98068

You can park in the main lot of the Alpentel ski area. Do not park in any reserved spots near the bridge. You can park anywhere else in that lot though. There is also overflow parking and an upper lot. Please do not park in the Demo Rep parking area.

We will be at Alpentel in the Denny Mt Lodge called the PowderHouse (on the 2nd floor of the west wing of the lodge). After you enter the plaza from the walkway, head to your right up the steps to the PowderHouse. We will be in the lefthand side of the room in the corner. Look for signs to point you in the right direction. It will be busy in the lodge as we have our silent auction and registration in the same room.

VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN:

- 1) Check in and get your Spree Pass & lift ticket from the Volunteer Check-In Table. Located on the main floor of the Powderhouse Lodge.
- 2) Sign the boring, yet necessary, event waivers*
- 3) Read over your volunteer role description and let us know if you have any questions

*NOTE: If you plan to demo gear you must head over to Sturtevant's Demo Form table over by registration to get a DIN card for trying demos. T-shirts are ONLY for team members this year. Please do NOT take t-shirts from t-shirt area!

If you have any questions during your shift you can come back to volunteer check-in or find your volunteer lead who you'll meet at the beginning of your shift. We will answer your question as soon as we can. If you have a later shift in the afternoon but want to get your Spree Pass and lift ticket for early activities, come check-in and pick them up. You are expected to show up for your shift at your scheduled time in the afternoon. The volunteer role you have chosen to fill is important for helping us have a successful event. Please make sure to show for the shifts you are scheduled.

WHAT TO BRING/WEAR:

Weather can be unpredictable. We recommend you dress warm and in layers. Better to bring more than less. Water proof jacket, hat and gloves are recommended. Also warm socks and shoes that will keep your feet dry. If you are up on the race course you will need to bring your ski/snowboard gear as well to help with the setup and timing. As a volunteer you may also take part in our silent auction and contests. We recommend bringing some cash for contests and raffles. If you plan on entering the beer garden you will need to have your I.D. with you as well. If you are going to demo ski and snowboard gear you will need to bring your own boots and poles. You can also rent them from the rental shop if you want. We do NOT provide boots and poles for demoing gear. Snowshoe gear is available though for anyone to try!
