From the I-5 N.E. 65th Street exit, head east approximately four miles on 65th (stay on the arterial route) until you have reached Sand Point Way N.E. Turn left on to Sand Point Way N.E. Turn right on the N.E. 74th Street entrance to Warren G. Magnuson Park (you will go under an arch way).

After you go under the arch, continue on 74th St NE until you reach a four-way stop. Take a left at the stop sign. Building 406 is the first building on the right hand side (white building). Follow the building around to the back-side parking lot and you will see the outdoors for all program office and green program tent.
