WINTER PRIVATE ADAPTIVE LESSONS

Private lessons are available to individuals interested in trying new
winter sports, looking for coaching to get to the next level, or as an
alternative for those who require flexibility to accommodate their
schedule. Lessons are two hours. All Private Lessons include equip-
ment rental and lift ticket. Lesson times scheduled based on registra-
tion date and availability. We make every effort to schedule lessons
which meet your preferred schedule.

ABILITY ASSESSMENT & EQUIPMENT FITTING

Ability Assessments and Equipment Fittings include one hour with an
Adaptive Recreation Instructor who will assess your individual abilities
and help you determine which adaptive equipment will be most appro-
priate for success in a new winter sport. Once the right equipment is
determined, the specialist will work with you to adapt equipment to
meet your individual needs utilizing adaptive grips, pads, and straps. An
introductory lesson on equipment use and recreation technique will fol-
low the fitting. Equipment rental for the day is included at no additional
charge. Family members and caregivers are welcome to attend to learn
along with the participant. Dates and times are subject to availabil-
ity. Sit, mono and bi ski equipment fittings can take place in Seattle as
well as on the mountain.

EQUIPMENT RENTALS

Outdoors for All equipment is available to rent for your lesson program
and for daily rentals. Winter equipment rentals include Downhill skis,
boots and poles, Nordic skis (skate and classic), boots and poles, Snow-
board and Boots, Sit, mono and bi-skis, and outriggers. Helmets are also
available at no cost for general safety use.
